Discussion:

1. June 22 Meeting Minutes

The minutes were approved as presented.

2. MFP Alert Groups Specification

The changes incorporated in the document since the last meeting were reviewed.

The following changes were discussed and agreed for the next version:

- In section 3.2, Use Model #1: Revise the sentence to clarify that the only change that needs to be made to Company A's management system is the ability to recognize the new MFD alert table groups.
- In Section 3.2, Use Model #2: Change "OCP" to "operator control panel" since this abbreviation is not universally recognized. Also, change "printing will continue" to "the owner of the new job can take the appropriate action so the operation can continue".
- In section 3.3, b) Revise the sentence "New alert groups are not to be defined for MFD components where equivalent groups already exist for the printer component" To "New alert groups are to be defined for MFD components where equivalent groups do not currently exist for the printer component"
- In section 3.3, d) Revise the last sentence "Note: this does prevent..." To "Note: this does not prevent..."
- Change "MFP" to "MFD" in Section 5, first line of text. Also in Section 11, title.

It was also suggested to include some specific rules to determine what constitutes an exact match in section 3.3 b. No specific rules were defined during the call. The only other comment was the example of creating a new general supplies group rather than reusing the current prtSupplies Group.

3. Proposed PrtAlertCodeTC

This is a new document that contains the new printer alert codes agreed to be added at the June 22nd meeting. It was agreed to keep these in a separate document, without using the standard PWG specification format, since it simply adds new entries to PrtAlertCodeTC. And none of the entries are unique to the MFD Alerts effort.

No comments or changes to the document were discussed.

4. Call for Volunteers to Prototype

Stuart indicated that Kyocera may be able to create a prototype. At least one other volunteer is needed to proceed.

5. Imaging System MIB

Ira was not on the call and there was no time left for this topic.
