2 General

- Meeting was convened at 11:00 EDT on 20 July, 2009.
- Notice was made that the meeting was held in accord with the PWG Intellectual Property Policy
- Bill Wagner agreed to take minutes
- The June Face-to-face minutes (<ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/wims/minutes/09JUN-Rochester-WIMS-CIM-face-to-face.pdf>) were accepted without comment.

3 Comments/Experiences with Proxy Provider Code Package

- No one (other than Rick) indicated that they had yet tried to exercise the code.
- Rick reported that he had received no communications about the code package.
- Rick is interested in feedback on user's experiences with the package, including any problems in running the package or bugs in the code,
- Rick indicated that he is still interested in getting more MIB dumps for application testing of the code.

4 Power Management

- As of 20 July, there have been no reactions to Ira's Power Management outline (<ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/wims/white/Power-Management-Model-Outline-20090623.htm>). This was attributed to Summer Doldrums, vacations, and reduced staffing for standards work.
- Bill suggested that, since there had been little time to discuss this outline at the last Face-to-face, we could expect a more active discussion at the meeting at Microsoft, especially Microsoft had indicated interest in this subject.
- Ira said that he would have an initial draft of the PWG Power Management Model spec in the next few weeks, well before the August meeting.
- Ira also indicated that he would be working on a MIB implementation as well as the abstract spec simultaneously.
- Rick noted that a utility produced for the Projector group could be used to allow an XML-formatted general definition to be translated into forms necessary for the different bindings. However, Ira felt that the relatively small number of objects did not warrant the complexity of the utility.

5 CIM Print Services

- Ira said that he had done further work on the CIM Services effort, although nothing further had been posted.
- Ira anticipated that completion of the [IPP/2.0](#) and the IPP Production Printing efforts would allow the elements associated with those efforts to be included.

6 Next Steps / Action Items

- Rick will review the messages from the past few months concerning problems in the current Printer associated CIM classes, most of which are believed to be in the Printer Class. He will generate a list of required fixes.
- Ira will generate a Power Management Elements Spec first draft
- The next WIMS conference call will be 27 July, with another anticipated on 10 August.
