General Discussion

- Minutes from the March 16th teleconference were accepted.
- The Call for Objections process was reviewed as stated in the PWG process document. The "clarification" path, although liberally interpreted, will be used.
 - Bill to send out on PWG-Announce this afternoon the "Call for Objections" for the white paper and CR which will end at the April face-to-face.

Next steps:

- New version of white paper to be submitted by Ira for additional changes to the CIM printing classes.
- Separate CRs should be written for each class requiring "non-trivial" changes. Trivial changes (small one or two line changes) can be combined into a single CR.
- o Order: Print Service, Print Job, and Print Queue
- Every property should have mapping stings and model correspondence (reference to parent property)

- CIM Core changes (feedback from CR) will be incorporated back into Ira's white paper.
- White paper with all CIM Core changes will become a PWG formal informational document (with approval).
- Final white paper will have link to CRs on the DMTF site (requires membership). CR approval statement will be included in the white paper.
- Rick has joined the CIM Core working group. As part of the alliance between DMTF and CIM core, the PWG can select a non-voting member to participate (including the weekly 9 a.m. teleconference on Fridays).
 - Craig will participate in the phone calls that have explicit agenda items pertaining to the CR/whitepaper/alliance.

Next Steps / Open Actions:

- Bill to send out on PWG-Announce this afternoon the "Call for Objections" for the white paper and CR which will end at the April faceto-face.
- Work to begin on additional classes (separate CRs) soon. Print service is next followed by queue and job. All of Phase I to be completed before Phase II.
