General Discussion

- Minutes from the April 26th face-to-face meeting (see <ftp://ftp.pwg.org/pub/pwg/wims/minutes/070426-NewJersey-WIMS-CIM-face-to-face.pdf>) were approved (change was made to add Bill, our chairman, to the list of attendees).
- Rick has provided an update on the output tray CR ballot (1 in favor to 0 against). There are no “quorum” or “majority” rules. Substantial comments usually taken back for additional edits.
- Additional CRs are in progress and are patterned after the output tray CR.
- Ira made changes to the MOF classes to better match the direction in SM 2.0 with limits, gages, and counters.
- Operating status is getting a new value to reflect changing state and status values. Subunit status / properties will reflect this.
- Rick to run the input tray CR through MOF Pretty in preparation for submission next week (highly analogous to the output tray CR).
- Ira will work on marker supply and marker colorant as a single submission.

- Binding channel and interpreter in a single submission was also suggested.
- Ira suggested removing channel information property to the CR. Perhaps this capability should be included in the migration of the Port Monitor MIB.
- Bill suggested replacing the weak channel information properties from the printer MIB with the properties in the Port Monitor MIB. This would also make it easier to generate a channel class / CR.
 - Consensus: remove channel information from the channel CR. The Port Monitor MIB will include “channel information” in a future Port Monitor CR.
 - Consensus: Port Monitor MIB should be added to the “CR radar”.

Imaging State and Counter MIB:

- Ira proposed adding values for scanner types: platens and ADF. Walt suggested this change to allow for independent counters for accounting purposes.
- ADF and platen should be treated as separate devices. Implementers can choose to implement just the scanner. Bill suggested running this idea by the MFD working group next week.
- Changes to the MIB should account for a future scanner MIB.

Next Steps / Open Actions:

- Ira will work on marker supply and marker colorant as a single submission.
- Ira will run the “scanner type” issue by MFD working group next week.
